





New Circle Hook Regulation

Effective January 1, 2008, all participants in billfish tournaments on the East Coast, the Gulf of Mexico and U.S. territories in the Caribbean will be required to use a non-offset circle hook when fishing with natural or natural/artificial bait combinations. This means that circle hooks will be required for the upcoming West Palm Beach tournament (when using live/natural baits or natural/ artificial combination baits).

Snapper Season Shortened

It looks as if the Snapper Season will be shortened in 2008 to June 1st thru September 30th. That means the annual Apalachicola tournament in April would fall outside of snapper season; the Tournament Committee is currently considering whether or not to change the dates for this tournament.
