When and Where:

- Planned Captain's Meeting: Thu Aug 8th, 6:30pm at East Point Beer Company. Website: <u>http://eastpointbeer.com/</u>
- Tournament fishing: Aug 9th-10th, (Fri-Sat) 2 Day Format
- Planned Photo Weigh-in: Text pictures to 470-233-0051 by 7:00pm Friday and 6:00pm Saturday
- Headquarters Our headquarters will be Bay City Lodge, Apalachicola. This is where the optional physical weigh-in will be and where our Awards Social event will be on Saturday evening
- Weigh-in times: By 7:00 pm Friday & 6:00 pm Saturday
- Awards Social: Saturday August 10th, 7:30pm at Steve's Cabin at Bay City Lodge

Other Tournament Information:

- Fuel Bay City fuel pumps often close prior to the end of the day's fishing. We'll work with them as much as possible to stay open later. They usually open by 0600 for morning fueling.
- Scoring per **Customized Catch and Release Matrix** (appended to this Tip Sheet). Boats must leave from anywhere between Mexico Beach and Carrabelle after the Captain's Meeting. There will be no location restrictions regarding state or federal waters.
- Rules Tournament will follow the Nearshore Rules and Guidelines with a customized matrix to include standard offshore species. Custom Matrix will be posted on the ASWSC Tournaments Web Page: <u>http://aswsc.org/tournaments/</u>
- Measuring Device as described in the Nearshore Rules Addendum, you must have an approved measuring device. You may want to bring a "device extender" if you catch a large AJ or King
- See below re: measuring rules:
 - The measuring device must have clearly visible minimum increments of ¼ inch and a vertical stop for the nose of the fish.
 - 2) The measuring device must be brought to the captain's meeting and must be approved by the tournament director.
 - 3) Fish caught that are longer than the measuring device will be counted at the longest measurement on the device.
- Physical Weigh-In A **physical weigh-in is not required**, but you're welcome to keep any legal fish for your own purposes. We will review the photo procedures at the captain's meeting.
 - We will follow the Nearshore Tournament Rules Addendum for scoring, etc: <u>http://www.aswsc.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/Nearshore-Tournament-Rules_01.20.2022.pdf</u>
 - It is not necessary to be landed to send pictures of your fish, nor do you have to stop fishing after weigh-in time on the first day of fishing. Any fish caught after the weigh-in deadline can be used for the following day. Stay out and fish if you want, but you must get your pictures texted in prior to weigh-in time.
- Scales Scales will be available. Please text Steve if you want to weigh in a fish for a possible club record or photo and he will arrange it.
- AOY/BOY Points This tournament will not count towards Angler or Boat of the Year awards
- Divisions There are no Nearshore nor Offshore divisions in this fun tournament. It is one open division. Fish where you want as long as it's between Carrabelle and Mexico Beach
- Cost This is a no cost and no-frills tournament. Don't expect fancy trophies but there will be bragging rights to be won. For the Awards Social feel free to bring your own drinks, adult beverages and chairs, we'll probably take a collection and order some carry out Pizza and/or Chinese.

Bay City Lodge/850-653-9294 - Cabins and Motel style rooms available. *Call for availability and make reservations ASAP*. Restaurant normally serves breakfast and dinner

Sportsman's Lodge/850-670-8423 – In Eastpoint FL, rates include boat dockage but it is very shallow and the docks are a step down from Bay City. In and out with a 21' boat was no problem. There is a free city ramp 1 block away for smaller boats. The ramp may be tight for larger boats.

Best Western Inn/850-653-9131 Smoking & non-smoking rooms are available. Free hot breakfast buffet 6:30 - 9:30

Water Street Hotel and Marina/850-653-3700 - Marina on-site can fit vessels up to 60 ft

- Sabiki rigs tipped with shrimp (optional) work well for pinfish, sand perch, etc.
- **Do not** try to use the water at Bay City to keep your bait, it is too fresh. Use seawater and an aerator to keep bait alive.
