Dockage is \$2.50 per foot if you are not staying in the marina houseboats, and trailer storage is included onsite. They have all you will need dockside to take care of your vessel.

#### **Boat Ramps:**

**Mahogany Mill Public Boat Ramp** / 1251 Mahogany Mill Rd, Pensacola, FL 32507. Large double public boat ramp with tie-up dockage that is 3.1 miles from Seville Harbour. I would recommend this ramp for most of our club boats. Large parking area for pre-launch and boat gear loading.

**17th Avenue Public Boat Ramp** / N 17th Ave, Pensacola, FL 32502. Public ramp that is 1.9 miles from Seville Harbour. This is a small one ramp "splash and go" place. No docks to tie up to, but if your boat is a bay boat or smaller, you can launch here and save some time.

#### **Trailer Storage:**

Included with any reservation for houseboats or wet slips at Seville Harbour. Contact the harbormaster with any questions when booking your slip.

**Twice the Ice / 3 locations /** You can download the Twice the Ice app from the Play/App store with directions to each of the three locations that are close to the marina.

<u>Circle K gas station/</u> 700 Bayfront Pkwy, Pensacola, FL 32502. 1.1 miles from Seville Marina via car. Has everything you would want from a large convenient store.

#### **Bait and Tackle:**

**Outcast Bait and Tackle-** Full bait and tackle store. If you forgot it, they have it. Plenty of frozen bait options and carry live shrimp and bull minnows. Open 5AM until 8PM daily.

**Directions to Pensacola-** If you are leaving from Atlanta, your goal for you should be to get to 185 South and follow until Montgomery, AL. Then take 165 South to exit 69 towards Pensacola and follow your navigation to your preferred launching location.

Once you have launched and your trailer is heading to the marina, you will see many more large signs for the Fish House than you will see for Seville Marina. The marina is directly behind the Fish House in the same parking lot. Our trailers will be placed in the gravel lot just across from the gated marina dock access.

**Fishing**- Seville Harbour will provide quick access to the Pensacola Pass and Gulf of Mexico without any "no wake zones." If you have not fished the area before and don't know where to go, the local guys at Strike Line Charts provide all of the public reef and wreck numbers free of charge for any type of GPS machine and file type:

You will be less than 20 miles from the pass to "the Ledge" which begins at 350ft deep and goes deeper from there for big game fishing. If you want to take a more laid-back approach, there is also great fishing inside of Pensacola Bay for big reds, gator trout, snapper, Spanish mackerel and many other species.
