ASWSC Members signed up for the King of Kingfish Challenge will weigh their largest Kingfish in at the MBARA tournament and based on those weights a club member will win the Crown with the largest Kingfish. (Separate from the MBARA tournament)

 Enter either division of the MBARA tournament ASWSC \$250/boat – paid to MBARA not

- Under 26' "Recreation" or Over 26' "Open"
 - Any boat with a professional on board must fish open
- You are fishing the MBARA tournament individually, not as an ASWSC club function, following all the tournament rules, fishing all the categories, and keeping all prizes.
- This is a great thing to do regardless of the ASWSC tie-in, several of us have fished it the last couple of years and it is a great tournament.
- Enter the ASWSC Kingfish Challenge \$10/angler paid to Mike Ball (The MBARA tournament fee is paid separately to MBARA
 - All MBARA Tournament rules apply
 - o All anglers on boat must enter, this is by individual angler not by boat
 - o Angler with Largest Kingfish (from ASWSC participants) wins
 - MBARA will weigh the fish, we will use their weights for our tournament
- Captain's Meeting The Captain's meeting on Friday night is great, they have food, live music and lots of door and raffle prizes, I highly recommend attending, it is big part of the experience.
 - o The MBARA Captain's Meeting will serve as the ASWSC Captain's meeting
- Awards Banquet Club member Allen Hill has a house close by and has offered for us to go there for the awards banquet after the weigh in
 - o 104 S. 25th Street, MB, FL
- Tie breaker earliest weigh-in
- Does not count toward Boat of the Year or Angler of the year
- The cost to be in both tournaments is not much more than entering one of our usual tournaments with a 4 person crew, with many more amenities (Great Captain's meeting and the chance to win prizes and cash)
