- Nearshore pictures may be sent anytime during the day, they must be received by submission deadline to count for that day.
- Awards Banquet: Saturday November 9th @ 7:30 PM. Location: Crooked River Grill – 151 Laughing Gull Lane, Carrabelle (in St. James Bay Golf & Pickleball Resort).

Other Tournament Information:

- Captains must elect to participate in the Nearshore or Offshore tournament when the application is submitted (participants may not participate in both divisions).
- Scoring - per the Nearshore and Offshore Points Matrices.
- Nearshore tournament boundaries will be Florida state waters, and nearshore participants must launch from Franklin County.
