

SCHEDULED PRESENTATION: DEEP DROPPING - TACKLE AND TACTICS

More and more anglers are becoming interested in exploring the mystery and treasures of deeper waters. We'll go over the fundamentals, including gear/tackle, rigging, and tactics, and give you an idea of what species you might bring up from the depths.



SCHEDULED PRESENTATION: CHUNKING FOR YELLOWFIN TUNA:

Chunking is the most reliable way to catch a yellowfin tuna. We'll explain how it works and what you need to know to catch these prized (and delicious) fish.



Member Mark Mleczo will give a brief presentation on how to catch swordfish, including equipment/tackle to use, rigging squid baits and putting out lines.

Members will be discussing fishing strategies and logistics for the upcoming Grand Isle tournament as well.
